- Night Ops: USAR Markings, Threats/Hazards, Weather Conditions, Pre-Planning, Risk vs. Recovery Assessment

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Wetsuit or drysuit
- Type "V" PFD
- Water boots/shoes
- Gloves (leather or synthetic palmed)
- Water helmet
- Flashlight
- Headlamp
- Chem sticks
- Throwbag



This course was designed for Fire, EMS, and Police to teach the skills necessary for rescue responses in an urban flood area. The course is 24 hours over two days with a Night Ops experience. The students will learn skills to manage an urban flood situation, as well as team safety, equipment use, and boat-based rescues.
